London buses, black taxi cabs, and the London Underground, commonly known as 'the Tube'! London is now a cosmopolitan, multicultural city which has attracted people from around the globe

only for the 'bright lights' - the theatres round Shaftesbury Avenue or the shops of Oxford Street. People
also take their children to visit Buckingham Palace, where the royal family lives, and the clock tower, from
